Difference between Mind and Mirror

The difference between the mind and the mirror is that the mirror only induces visual images which are seen by the eye but mind induces visual images and others from the various sensual and rational senses.

The *Mahsus*(Sensual) are things which are known and perceived by one of the five senses: sight, hearing, smell, taste and touch...

... but the *Ma'qul* (rational) are things which are known and perceived without the five senses like 'Two is even and one is odd.'

The Difference between Tasawwur and Tasdeeq

If the image which occurs in the mind is an ascription of one thing to another, it's called *Tasdeeq* and if there is no ascription it's called *tasawwur*.
