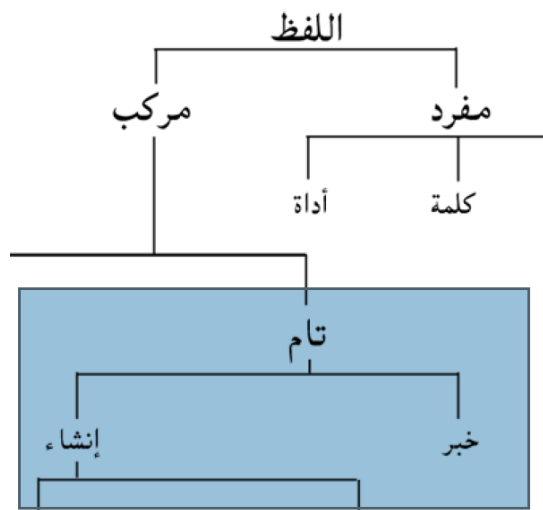


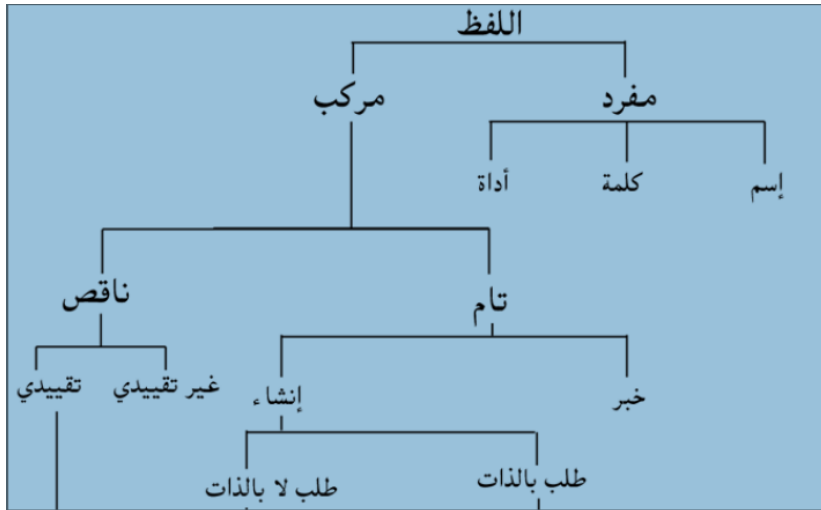
1) **Taamm** (complete)

When the expression is **complete** and does not need any addition; e.g. Ali is here.

Taam is divided to:

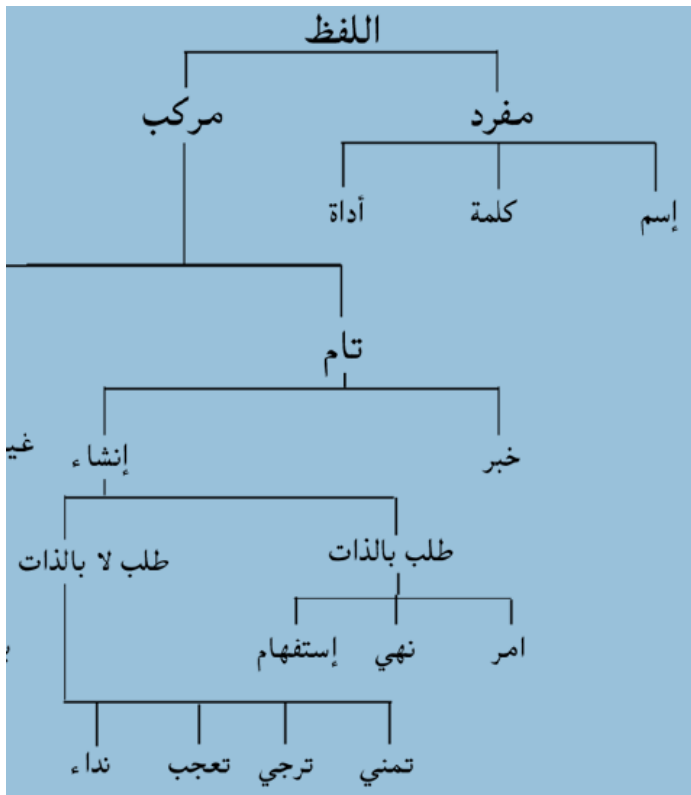
- 1) **Khabar** (informative); which **can be true or false**; e.g. **Ali came**.
- 2) **Inshaa'** (creative): which is **not true or false**; e.g. **come here**.





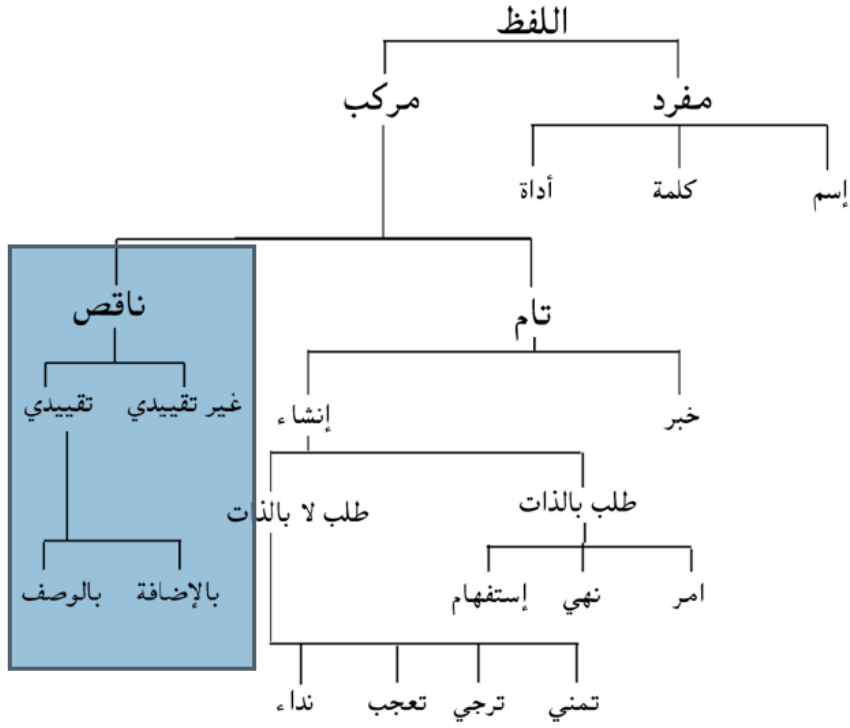
Inshaa' is either:

- **Frankly**; such as the command verb, prohibitive command verb and interrogative
- **Not frankly**; such as wishing, hoping, surprise or calling.



2) **Naqis** (defective) is either:

- **Murakkab Taqyeedi** (bound compound)
- **Ghair Taqyeedi** (unbound compound)



- **Murakkab Taqyeedi** (bound compound):

A word which has two parts and the second is bound to the first and [the intention is not understood from the first without the second](#); e.g. house of Ali or Ali who is knowledgeable

- **Ghair Taqyeedi** (unbound compound)

In which the intention from the first part's meaning is [understood with or without the second](#); e.g. خمسة عشرة (15) in which خمسة(5) is known without عشرة (10).
