Arabic Alphabet (ذ-ر)

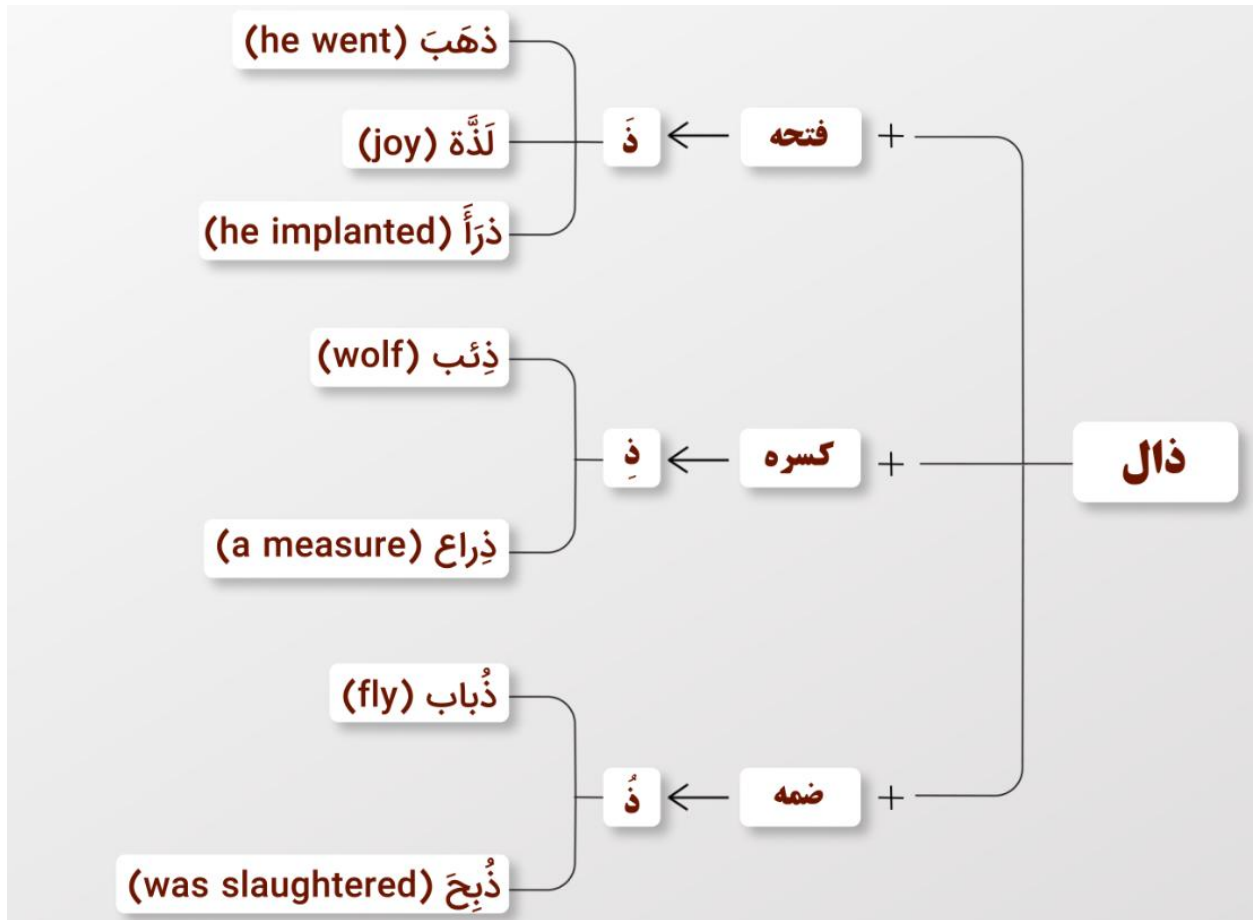

“We narrate to you the best of narratives by our revealing to you this Quran, though before this you were certainly one of those who certainly did not know.”

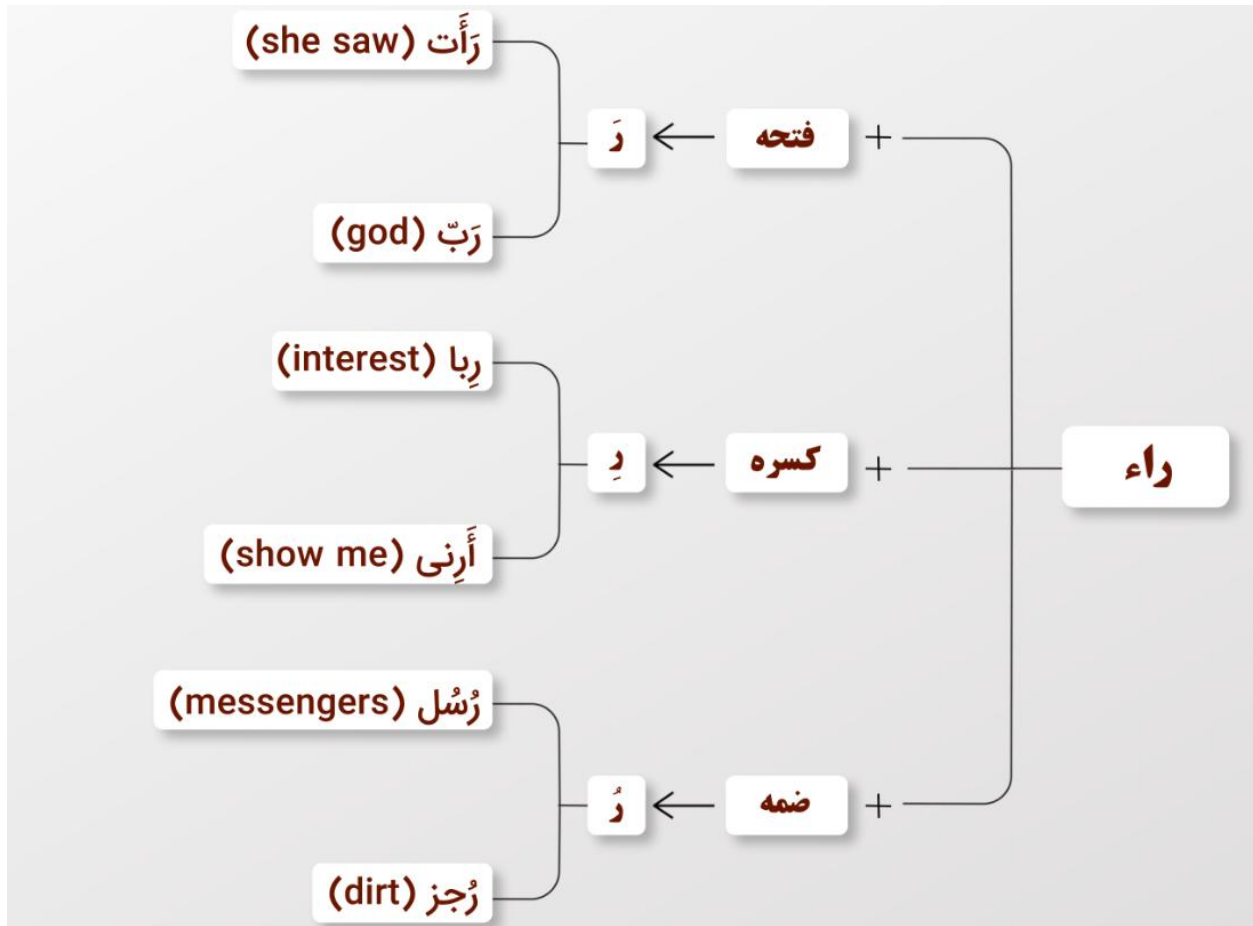
