## Arabic Alphabet in writing

↓ In Arabic language, it is proper to greet each other by:

Assalamu alaykum : السلامُ عليكُم

Each of the letters has a basic form, but modifications in their shapes occur according to their position in words.

A number of letters share the same shape and are only distinguished by diacritic dots. For example:

## نوح Nūn as in : ن

- ْكَتَبَ' Tā' as in 'كَتَبَ
- 'كَوِثَر' Thā' as in 'كَوِثَر
- 'ابراهيم' Bā' as in 'براهيم

## 'یعقوب' Yā' as in 'یعقوب

The letters «i – j – j – g – j – are only connected with the respective preceding letter, whereas all the others are connected with both sides.
