The Passive Voice Verb (الفِعلُ المَجهول)

Past Tense Passive Voice Verb

This verb is derived from the past tense active voice verb.

Formation:

The vowel on the first original letter gets changed from Fathah to Dhammah (فُعَلَ $\rightarrow \dot{b}$). The second step is to change the vowel on the second original letter to kasrah (فُعِلَ $\rightarrow \dot{b}$). According to this, the past tense passive voice verb has only this one pattern.

As previously said, the passive voice is conjugated according to the proxy subject (نائب الفاعل).

Present Tense Passive Voice Verb (المُضارعُ المَجهول)

This verb is derived from the present tense active voice verb.

Formation:

Frist, the particle of the present tense gets Dhammah (يَفَعَلُ \leftrightarrow يُفَعَلُ) and then the second original letter gets Fathah. Therefore there is only one pattern or Wazn for this verb.
