1. **'جائز الوجهين'** (both-permissible), in which each one is permissible and that is when the 'عامل' gives 'نصب' to two pronouns as its objects, the first of which is known more than the second.

الكتاب أعطَيتُكَهُ / الكتاب اعطيتُكَ إيّاهُ: Example

Or when the second pronoun is accusative by ' \ge ' and its family. In this case the second pronoun can be apart or connected.

الصديق كنته – الصديق كنت إيّاه :Example

نون الوقاية مع الضمائر· 2.

'نون الوقاية' (protective Nun) is a 'مبنی' (inflexible) letter with Kasra which comes after some 'عامل' s (effecters) when they come on the first person 'ی to prevent confusion between the words.

It is used in two ways:

 A) **واجب** (necessary), that is when the 'عامل' of 'عامل' is a verb or a verbnoun or 'قَد', 'لَذُن', 'عَن', 'مِن', 'ليت' .
Example: 'قَوْمِ لِمَ تُؤَدُونَنِي (When Moses said to his people, 'O my people! Why do you torment me...)

Example: ''يَوْمَ يَنْظُرُ الْمَرْءُ مَا قَدَّمَتْ يَدَاهُ وَيَقُولُ الْكَافِرُ يَا لَيْتَنِي كُنْتُ تُرَابًا'' (the day when a person will observe what his hands have sent ahead and the faithless one will say, 'I wish I were dust!')

B) **بائز'** (permissible), and that is when it is preceded by 'لَكِنَّ ' , 'أَنَّ ' , ' أَنَّ ' , 'أَنَّ ' , ' أَنَّ ' , ' أَنَّ ') ' , 'أَنَّ ' , ' أَنَّ ' , 'أَنَّ ' , 'أَنَّ ' , 'أَنَّ ' , ' أَنَّ '

"إنَّنى أنا الله": "Example:

"إنى ظَنَنْتُ أَنّى مُلاقٍ حِسابيَه" Example:

Note:

When 'نون الوقاية' gets together with the 'ن' of plural feminine or of emphasis, they cannot merge (ادغام).

Example: ''قَالَ رَبِّ السِّجْنُ أَحَبُّ إِلَيَّ مِمَّا يَدْعُونَنِي إِلَيْهِ'' Example: ''حَتَّى تُوْتُون مَوْثِقًا مِنَ اللَّهِ لَتَأْتُنَنِي بِهِ'' : Example

And when it gets together with the ' $\dot{\upsilon}$ ' in the five-verbs (the present tense verbs which have ' $\dot{\upsilon}$ ' except seeghah 6 & 12), it is permissible to merge, to part or to omit one of them.

Example: "إِنَّ الْقَوْمَ اسْتَضْعَفُونِي وَكَادُوا يَقْتُلُونَنِي" Example: "قُلْ أَفَغَيْرَ اللَّهِ تَأْمُرُونِي أَعْبُدُ أَيُّهَا الْجَاهِلُونَ
