The principles in the verb-like prepositions:

The *khabar* does not precede its noun, except when it is 'ظرف' or ' ظرف' or ' مجرور and the noun is definite.

Example: "إنّ إلينا إيابهم"

This precession is necessary in some cases. Please refer to page 147.

- They remain the same but sometimes they get slighted and said as ' إِنْ أَنْ أَنْ
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- 3. The *khabar* must be mentioned except with an indicator.

Notes:

1. 'لام الابتداء', provided that it is positive and not in the past tense.

"و إنّ ربّك أذو مغفرة للنّاس" Example:

 Sometimes 'نون الوقاية' joins these prepositions when their noun is firstperson 'ى'.

"يا ليتنى كنتُ معهم" Example:

3. Sometimes 'ضمير الفصل' comes between the noun and khabar of them.
