Topic: Salat al-Jama'ah & Salat al-Ayat

The Congregational Prayer

It is *mostahab* to perform the obligatory *salah*, especially the daily ones in congregation (*Jama'ah*), in particular for the neighbors of the mosque, and those who hear the mosque's *adhan*.

It is permissible if the follower performs an obligatory *salah* other than the one the imam performs.

Criteria of Jama'ah Imam

- 1. Adolescent
- 2. Sane
- 3. Shi'a (or follower) of the twelve Imams
- 4. Performs the salah in the correct way
- 5. 'Adil (just)...
 - It is mandatory for the *ma'moom* not to perform *Takbirat-el- Ehram* before the imam.
 - It is mandatory for the *ma'moom* to perform all the parts of the *salah* himself, with the exception of the recitation of *al-Hamd* and the surah.
 - If the *ma'moom* joins the *jama'ah* late while the imam is still to stand up from his *rukoo'*, he/she can say *takbeer* and follow the imam and that is considered the first *rak'ah*.

Occasions of Salat al-Ayat

- 1. Sun eclipse
- 2. Moon eclipse
- 3. Earthquake

4. Thunder, lightning, thunderbolt, fierce black and red winds, and suchlike if most people fear them

Procedure of Salat al-Ayat

Salat al-ayat consists of two rak'ah, in each rak'ah there are five rukoo'... one surah before each rukoo'.

Two Ways to Perform the Salat al-Ayat

- A) To recite al-*Hamad* and another complete surah before every of the five *rukoo*'s
- B) To recite al-*Hamd* and a part of a surah which is divided to five parts and bow for *rukoo*' and then only another part of the divided surah before the other four *rukoo*'s.
