Lesson 102 The Types of Definition (اقسام التعريف) mamSadig.ty

- 'التعريف اللفظى' (literal definition) is not a real definition, and therefore, it is not discussed in the science of Logic; rather, the known conception which clarifies the unknown conception and is an answer to 'ما الشارحة او الحقيقية' is the logician's subject of study.
- (complete definition) is to define by all the essentials of the definiendum, and that is by the proximate genus and species; e.g., answering definiendum, and that is by the proximate genus and species; e.g., answering 'ديوهر', 'الجسم النامى' because', because' رالحيوان' because' ما الانسان?' and 'and', 'الحساس المتحرك بالارادة', all of which are essential to'
- ا س a proximate genus and the property(خاصة), which contains both the 'ذاتی' and d i q . t v 'الحيوان of the subject and, therefore, it is called 'تام' (complete) such as 'الحيوان 'انسان' for الضاحک'
 - 'الحد الناقص' (incomplete definition) is to define by some of the essentials, i.e., the proximate 'فصل' alone or by that and the distant 'الجسم , such as 'الجسم 'alone for 'ناسان'. It is to define by only the 'خاصة' (property), such as 'خاصة' alone for 'انسان', so it contains only the 'عرضی' and therefore, it is called 'ناقص' (incomplete).

1. The first answer to the question can be by the proximate genus and

- species, e.g., speaking animal 'الحيوان الناطق'
- The second can be by "جسم نام حساس متحرك بالارادة ناطق" which is also a complete definition "حد تام" and has more detail because there is the complete definition of animal حيوان.
