Lesson 108 Conditions of the Definition (1) (شرائط التعريف)

- Conditions of Definition: The purpose of a definition is to understand the definiendum's concept and distinguish it from other concepts. This purpose is not met except with five conditions:
 - The definiendum and the definer must be equal both in the instances, i.e., the definer must be 'مطرد و منعکس' or 'مانع و جامع' and that means it must include all the instances of the definiendum and exclude all the others. In this condition:
 - The definer should not be more inclusive 'اعم' than the definiendum because it also includes others.
- ⊕ Im a m S a ✓i The definer should not be less inclusive because it is not a m S a d i q t v comprehensive enough.
 - ✓ The definer should not be alien to the definiendum because aliens cannot be predicated on each other.
 - 2. The definer must be clearer than the definiendum to serve the purpose of definition; therefore, defining through something equally unknown or by a less familiar concept is useless.

In this condition:

- ✓ The definer and definiendum should not be equal in their ambiguity and clarity.
- ✓ The definer should not be more ambiguous than the definiendum.

The definer must not be the same in concept. There must be a difference between the definiendum and the definer, either in brevity and elaboration (as in 'الحد التام') or in concept; otherwise, the vicious circle (دور) would happen (the definiendum being known before getting known), and it entails that something depends on itself; which is impossible.
