  - God has given scholars a high station, excellence and superiority over all other creatures but His messengers. Their superiority is like the sun over the stars, the next world compared to this and His greatness compared over the universe.
  - Jesus said; if someone is decorated with knowledge and conforms his behavior to his knowledge then he is mentioned with greatness in the skies.

  - Abu Dhar Ghafari:
