## Nahj al-Balaghah Lesson 8 The Creation of Human – The Soul

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- Two figures are mentioned in the Quran as people in whom Allah blew His soul in (while it is true about every human being) as a clearer sign of God (since they had no father) Prophet Adam (as) and Prophet Isa (as).
- The Holy Prophet and Ahl al-Bait (A) had an existence of light, long before their physical existence.
- The word 'روح' is taken from the root 'ريح' (wind) which always moves around,
- Just like the wind keeps the world healthy, the soul also, keeps the body alive and healthy.

## Signs of the existence of soul:

- 1. One clue of the existence of soul is understanding abstract concepts.
- 2. Another clue is that if a person's body is recreated somehow, we can't consider it as to be the same person.
- 3. Another clue is that the body cells would change from time to time but the constant personality that we refer to as "I" or "you" would not.
  - The voluntary decisions of a human are made not by the material cells in our body (because they cannot), but by the soul.



• The soul defines your identity and makes your decisions but its connection to the body is through the brain. That's why a brain-dead person is rather dead.

*Nafs* 'نفس' are sometimes used interchangeably. It seems that the link between the physical body and the abstract soul is *nafs* which is the innate faculty for the human to operate.

*Nafs* is of three types:

1. *Ammarah*: The tempting *nafs* which propels you to fulfill your desires even if haram. *'Iffah'* (عفّة) or chastity is against this *nafs*.

The ammarah nafs is a wild beast that needs to be tamed, so we need to occasionally go against even our halal desires to strengthen our soul and self-control.

2. *Lawwamah*: The self-reproaching *nafs* which rebukes and gives the sense of guilt when a person commits evil. This *nafs* is a blessing of God which helps for repentance.

3. *Muțma'innah*: The certain *nafs* which is completely satisfied with Allah (SWT).

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
