

Arabic Alphabet (ن - م)

The Holy Prophet (PBUH&HP):

«أَفْضَلُ الْعِبَادَةِ قِرائَةُ الْقُرْآنِ»

“The best (act of) worship is recitation of the Qur'an.”

Letter	Name	Transliteration	Pronunciation
م	ميم	Meem	The equivalent English letter is 'M' as in 'Melon'

ميم + فتحه : م ← مَلُوم (blamed)

م ← مَن (who)

ميم + كسره : م ← مِن (from)

م ← مِرَاء (quarrel)

ميم + ضمه : مُ ← مُؤْمِنِين (the faithful)

م ← مُسْلِمِين (the Muslims)

Letter	Name	Transliteration	Pronunciation
ن	نون	Noon	The equivalent English letter is 'N' as in 'Never'

«نون و القلم و ما يَسْطُرُون»

نون + فتحه : نـ (we see) ← ئىرى

(he forgot) ← ئىسىـ

نون + كسره : نـ (women) ← ئىسـاء

(women) ← ئىسـوة

نـ + ضمه : نـ (we show) ← ئىرى

(detest) ← ئۇرـا

Letter	Name	Transliteration	Pronunciation
ھ	ھاء	Haa'	The equivalent English letter is 'H' as in 'Hand'

ھاء + فتحه : ھـ (he guided) ← ئەدىـ

(he tried) ← ھـمـ

ھاء + كسره : ھـ (he gets guided) ← ئېدىـ

(we call for (Allah's) curse) ← ئېتـلـ

ھاء + ضمه : ھـ (guidance) ← ئەدىـ

(right here) ← ھـاـنـا

(has been destroyed) ← ھـدـمـتـ
