Lesson 1

- According to the Holy Prophet (PBUH&HP) the recitation of the Holy Quran **enlightens homes.**

- Similarly he (PBUH&HP) said: The **best religious ritual** is the recitation of the Quran.

- The predominant mode of recitation in the Muslim word is taken form the narration of Hafs who in turn narrates from 'Asim. It known as the recitation of **Hafs 'An Aasim.**

- Some of the recommended etiquettes of reciting the Holy Quran are;

- To have Wudhu. it becomes **obligatory** if one intends to touch the words of the Quran.

- To brush
- To sit respectfully towards the Qibla
- To look at the verse while reciting
- To begin recitation with Basmalah and Isti'azah
- To read clearly and distinctly without rushing
- To ponder on the meaning of the verses

- Imam Sajjad (a) says; 'O Allah! Make the Quran a ladder by which I may climb to the place of safety.

- To not leave the Quran open and unattended

- Vowels are divided into two;

- Short vowels

- Long vowels

- Short vowels are;

- Fatha ()
- Kasra ()
- Dhamma (-́)

- Long vowels are (۱، و، ی).

- The difference between the short and the long vowel is in the length the extended sound and not in its pronunciation.

- By extended the short vowel ($\hat{-}$) the long vowel of (†) is made.
- By extending the short vowel () the long vowel of (ω) is made.
- By extending the short vowel ($\dot{-}$) the long vowel of (\cdot) is made.
