Nafilah of the maghrib prayer

Its time sets after performing the *maghrib* prayer and lasts until when the reddish Im a afterglow on the western horizon vanishes.d iq.tv Im a m S a d iq.tv

Nafilah of the 'isha prayer

It is two *rak'ahs* (while sitting) and its time is after the *'isha* prayer till midnight; and it is better to be done after all the other recommended acts of worship.

Salat al-Layl

Time of salat al-layl begins after midnight, and extends until daybreak, and it is

better to be offered as close as possible to daybreak.

It is not permissible to offer it before midnight, except for a traveler or a youth who cannot wake up at dawn, and offering its *qada*' is better. The end of its time is (the second) daybreak.

If the daybreak sets in while he has not performed four *rak'ah*s of it (night \oplus 1 m a m S a prayer), he must involve in the *fajr* prayer or its *nafilah*. \oplus 1 m a m S a d i g t v

Nafilah of the fajr prayer

Its time is after (the first) daybreak till the rise of the reddish afterglow, after which performing the *fajr* prayer is preferable.
