Qiyam

Qiyam (standing) is a rukn, when one is able to stand. When one makes any

^(m) error in it, whether intentionally or inadvertently, his salat will be batil. S a d i q t v

Points:

If one is able to stand independently, it will be *wajib* upon him to stand.
 Otherwise (if be unable), he is required to recline on any support that enables him to stand. It is also said that it is permissible to recline on a wall.

4 It is *wajib* to do the prayer standing as much as the person can.

- If one who performs *salat* while sitting, can stand for performing *ruku*', it will be obligatory on him to do so.
- If one cannot stand, he may perform the *salat* sitting, and if not possible, lying on the right side facing the *qiblah*, and if not possible either, lying on his back. The latter two can make gestures with their heads for *ruku*' and *sujud*.



The person who is unable to perform *sujud*, he may lift up the thing (clay) on which he may prostrate. If this be not possible for him, he can make gestures (by blinking his eyes).
