Three rules regarding the *sujud*

- 1. **If a person has a hindrance** that prevents him from laying his forehead on the ground he is required to dig a **hole** so as to make the healthy part touch the ground. If not possible, he may perform *sujud* on any of the two **brows** or else he can do it on his **chin**.
- 2. **The** *sujuds* of Qur'an are fifteen, four of which are *wajib* and they are in the following *Surahs: Fussilat, Ha Mim al-Sajdah, al-Najm, and al-'Alaq.* In these four, it is *wajib* on the reciter and the listener to prostrate.

The sujuds of the qur'an do not necessarily need taharah, facing the qiblah and so on.

3. **Performing two** *sujuds* **of thankfulness** (*shukr*) **is** *mustahabb* in time of renovation of **blessings**, and repellence of an indignation, and following the prayers. *Ta'fir* is *mustahabb* in between them.
