Section Three Section Three Manner of Performing Tayammum

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- *Tayammum* is not valid if performed before the time sets in for *salat*, and it is valid if very little time is left for obligatory *salat*.
- There is disagreement regarding its validity with availability of enough time. Prohibition is nearer to precaution.
- The wajibs in tayammum are: the niyyah that must be continued, and sequence (tartib): ...

The Sequence in *Tayammum*:

Striking with the palms on the earth, **wiping the upper part of the forehead** where the hair grows, **to the upper part of the nose** (including the eyebrows), then striking a second time and **wiping the entire back of the hands**.

Tayammum in two ways:

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- If the hands (*kaffayn*) are amputated, their wiping will be dropped and only wiping the forehead is to be performed. If a part of them is cut, he can wipe the rest.

 - If a person performs *tayammum* with *najasah* being present on his body (other than the *tayammum* parts), his *tayammum* is valid.

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
