- *Mu'rab* words are the words that get different "*i'rab*" signs when their status in the sentence changes.
- *Mabni* Words are the words that do not get different "*i'rab*" signs even if their status in the sentence changes.

Some Nouns are Mu'rab and some are Mabni

(Why are they mabni?)

for some resemblance that gets them close to the prepositions)



Noun (إسم):

Mu'rab (معرب): A noun that is free from any resemblance to the prepositions (حروف)

Mabni (مبنی): A noun that resembles one of the prepositions (حروف)

The Types of Resemblance (between mabni words and prepositions):
