Lesson 23 Substitutive *I'rab* Signs

There are some substitutive *i'rab* signs, such as:

- a. 'و' (for raf'), as in 'و' 'أخو' 'أخو'
- b. 'ا' (for *nasb*), as in 'أخا' 'أبا
- c. 'ع' (for *jarr*), as in 'بنِی' 'أبِی' '

Words that get substitutive *i'rab* signs:

1. The-six-nouns (الاسماءُ الستّة) which get 'و،اءي' for raf', nasb and jarr.

'in the state of raf', nash and jarr: 'الاسماء الستّة

- 'أبو، أبا، أبي ﴿ ﴿ 'أَبِ
- 'أخو، أخا، أخِي' → 'أخ'. 2.
- 'حَمو، حما، حمى' → 'حَم'
- 'هَنو، هنا، هنی' → 'هَن'
- 'فو، فا، فِي' → 'فَم'
- 6. 'ذو' ذا، ذِی' → 'ذو' دا اس a m S a diq.tv
