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General Conjunctive Nouns

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Specific Conjunctive Nouns

| | Singular | Dual | Plural |
|--------|----------|------------------|-----------------|
| Male | اللذى | اللذان/اللذّينِ | اللذينَ/الأَليٰ |
| Female | اللتى | اللتانِ/اللتَينِ | اللاتِ/اللاء |

Note: 'أولىٰ' is sometimes used for the female plural.

General Conjunctive Nouns

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و مَن و ما و ال تساوى ما ذُكر و هكذا ذو عند طَيٍّ قد شُهِر

'مَن، ما، ال' are equal to the mentioned (conjunctives) and also 'ذو' for the Ṭayy tribe

> و كالّى ايضاً لديهم ذاتُ و موضع اللاتى أتى ذواتُ 'الّى' can replace 'ذاتُ' For them, 'اللاتى' can replace 'ذوات' and

Examples:

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جاءني من قام/قاما/قاموا/قامَت/قامتا/قُمنَ

أعجبني ما رُكِبَ/رُكِبا/رُكبوا/رُكبَت/رُكِبَتا/رُكبْنَ

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جاءني القائم/القائمان/القائمون/القائمة/القائمتان/القائمات

Most of the time, '\o' is used for the unintelligent. However, sometimes it is used for the intelligent, such as in:

«فَانْكِحُوا مَا طَابَ لَكُمْ مِنَ النِّسَاءِ» نساء/3 "Marry of the women, who seem good to you"



Most of the time, 'مَن' is used for the intelligent. However, sometimes it is used for the unintelligent, such as in:

هُمْ مَنْ يَمْشِي عَلَىٰ أَرْبَعٍ ۚ يَخْلُقُ اللَّهُ مَا يَشَاءُ» نور/45 «مِنْهُمْ مَنْ يَمْشِي عَلَىٰ أَرْبَعٍ ۚ يَخْلُقُ اللَّهُ مَا يَشَاءُ» نور/45 "Among them are some that walk on four. Allah creates whatever He wishes"

'لا' is a conjunctive noun, but some believe it is a conjunctive preposition and some believe that it is only for definition (من' and 'من' (the one which is not replaceable with an infinitive) are consecutively nouns. The 'ما' that is replaceable with an infinitive is a preposition.

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
