# ImamSadiq.tv The Referring Pronoun (الضمير العائد) = mamSadiq.tv (الضمير العائد)

أَىّ كَما و أعربَت ما لم تُضَف و صدرُ وصِلِها ضميرٌ انحذف

'أَى'' is like 'Ы' (in keeping the same form) and it is mu'rab as long as it is not added

while its clause begins with an omitted (yet assumed) pronoun

Some of the Arabs consider 'أَى' as *mu'rab* in all the four statuses even in the fourth, such as in 'مررتُ بأيّهم قائمٌ', 'مررتُ بأيّهم قائمٌ ' and 'رأيتُ أيّهم قائمٌ ' .

و بعضهم أعرب مطلقاً و في ذا الحذفِ أيّاً غيرَ أيّاً يقتفي

Some consider it absolutely mu'rab and (some) others (conjunctives) follow 'أَى' in this omission (of the referring pronoun)

The pronoun referring to the conjunctive gets omitted when:

• It is in the state of *raf'* while it is *'mubtada'* and its predicate is *mufrad* (not a sentence), such as in 'هو الذى في السماء إلهُ' and '…' and '…'

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
