Lesson 64

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The pronoun referring to the conjunctive gets omitted when ...

- It is in the state of *raf*'
- While it is 'mubtada'
- Its predicate is *mufrad* (not a sentence)

So 'جاءنى اللذان ضُرِبَ' or 'جاءنى اللذان قُرَبَ' is not correct, for the pronoun is in the state of *raf*' because it is the subject or its substitute.

• (and) The clause is long (in other than 'أىّ), such as in 'جاء الذى (هو) ضاربٌ زيداً'

"ما أنا بالّذي (هو) قائلٌ لک سوءاً»

Note:

If the clause is not long, omission of the referring pronoun is rare (The Kufi grammarians disagree though), as in 'تماماً على الذى (هو) أحسنُ" or 'جاء الذى (هو)
