Hayd & Istihadah

Rules Applicable to a *Ha'id*

1. It is forbidden to divorce a *ha'id* if they have had intercourse, and he is not travelling.
2. On her attaining *taharah*, she should perform the *ghusl*, which is exactly like *ghusl al-Janabah*, but it differs in whether ablution should be performed prior to *ghusl* or following it, with performing the *qada'* of *sawm* not the *salah*.
3. It is *mustahabb* for her to perform *wudu'* for each and every *salah*, by sitting in her place of worship at the time of her *salah*, remembering Allah the Exalted. *Khidab* is *makruh* (reprehensible) for her.

Section Three: *Istihadah*

Types of *Istihadah*:

***Istihadah* blood is usually yellowish, cold, light and flows out slowly.** With this description, it may agree with *hayd*, as yellowness and density during days of *hayd* are *hayd* and during days of *tuhr* (purity) are *tuhr (istihadah)*.
