## Lesson 16

### Types of *Mu'rab* (أقسام المعرب)

● *Sahih & Mu'tall* (الصحيح والمعتل) ImamSadiq.tv

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و معرب الأسماء ما قد سلما

من شبه الحرف كأرضٍ و سُما

*Mu'rab noun is that which is free ...*

*from any resemblance to prepositions; such as 'أرض' and 'سُما'*

● From one aspect, *mu'rab* is divided to: ImamSadiq.tv

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- *Sahih* (sound)
- *Mu'tall* (weak)

*Mu'tall* is a noun that ends with و-ا-ى; and *sahih* is the word that is free from the weakness of these letters. و-ا-ى are weak (*i'lah*) because they undergo certain kind of changes called (*i'lal*).

● *Munsarif and Ghair-Munsarif* (المنصرف و غير المنصرف) ImamSadiq.tv

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From another aspect, *mu'rab* is divided to:

- *Munsarif* (totally-capable of having different *i'rab* signs); e.g. 'زيد'
- *Ghair-Munsarif* (partly-capable of having different *i'rab* signs); e.g. 'أحمد'
