Substitutive *I'rab* Signs in Plural Nouns

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Regular masculine plural (الجمع المذكر السالم) is a masculine plural in which the construction of the singular is not broken.

The attachments of regular masculine plural noun (in *i'rab*):

- 'عشرون' and the like (they do not have singular forms)
- 'أهلون' (which is non-derivative but not a proper noun)
- 'أولوا' (does not have a singular form)
- 'عالمون' (which is non-derivative but not a proper noun)
- 'عليون' (which is not a name for an intelligent thing)
- 'أرضون', 'سنون' and the like (which are non-derivative, their singulars are feminine and not proper nouns)

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
