The Connected Hamza

-According to the Arabic Rules it is Impossible to pronounce a word beginning with a Sukun or a Shaddahh.

- However, due to Grammatical Issues. in some cases we have words which begins with a Sukun or a Shaddah

- Therefore we have to Add an Alif/Hamza هَمْزَةُ الْوَصْلِ to the beginning of such words in order to pronounce them.

-This Hamza is known as the Connected Hamza

- Sign of a Connected Hamza is a small incomplete (ص) like أ

- Hamzat al-Wasl is not pronounce is it comes in the middle of a sentence like e.g. رَبِّ انصُرْنِي

Beginning with the Connected Hamza

- 2 Types of Pronunciations for Hamzah al-Wasl if it's at the beginning of a Verb

a. Dhamma

b. Kasrah

- Kasrah, if it's at the beginning of a Noun.

- Fathah, if it's at the beginning of the article AL 'ال'
