✓ 2 Types of Orphans

- 1- (In Islam) One **without father**.
- 2- One who is **deprived of his Imam** and religious leader, and does not know about his religious duty.

✓ Reward for showing **affection towards an orphan** (one without a father)

Imam Hasan Askari (s) narrates that the Prophet of God said:

- God has encouraged people **to do good to the orphans**.
 - People are responsible to be their **guardians**, because they have lost their fathers.
 - If someone strokes the head of an orphan affectionately, the Exalted Lord will give him a palace larger than the world and all that which is in it **for each hair** that his hand passes over.
- ✓ According to the Imam, **The orphan who is deprived of his Imam is in a direr situation** than the orphan without a father.
- If one of our followers, who have obtained knowledge about us, guides another person, he is like a guardian who is caring for an orphan.
- ✓ Rank of Someone who guides others
- He will have a distinguished shining crown on his head and clothes, **one thread of which would be more valuable than all of the world** and that which is in it.
 - He will be dignified as a **student of the descendents of the Prophet (s)**
 - The scholar, along with all the people who he has guided will be **accompanied by him to the luminous expanse of Heaven**.
