

Lesson 20

Cases where the letters Waw (و) and Yaa (ي) are not pronounced

a. When the wo letters are not accompanied by any vowel and are situated after the short Alif (أ) e.g. صَلَّوْة

b. When the two letters (و and ي) function as a 'seat' for Hamzah.

If the long Vowels (Madd) are followed by Hamzat al-Wasl → the Madd pronunciation becomes Silent.

Joining two Sakin Letters

Two Sakin Letters together cannot be pronounced.

In cases where there is a Taween at the end of the 1st word and the 2nd word begins with hamzat al-Wasl like عَرَضْنَا and the 2nd word like الَّذِينَ .

In such cases we should give a Kasrah to Noon of the Tanween (ن) . If you do not stop at عَرَضْنَا you will read it as: عَرَضْنَا الَّذِينَ
