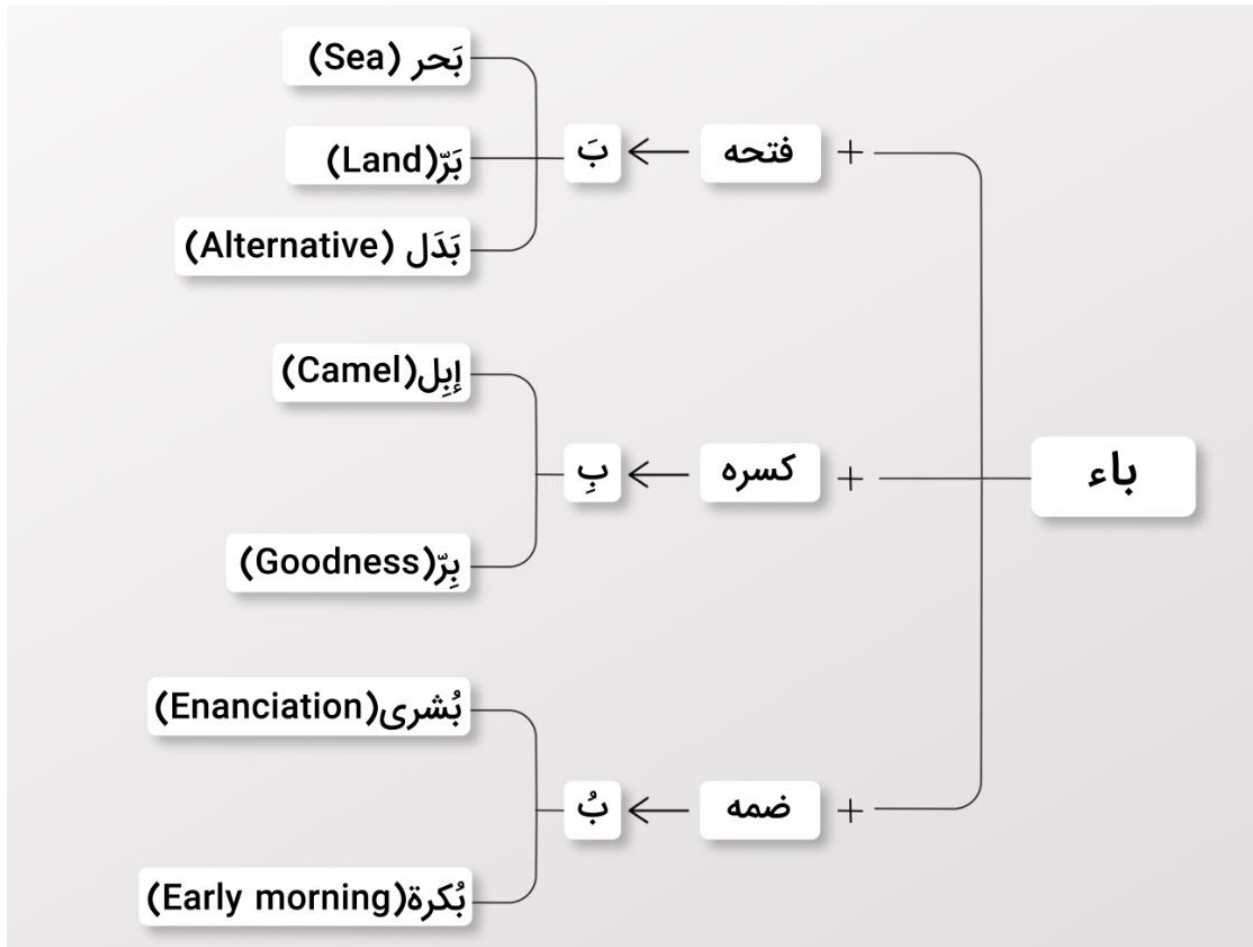

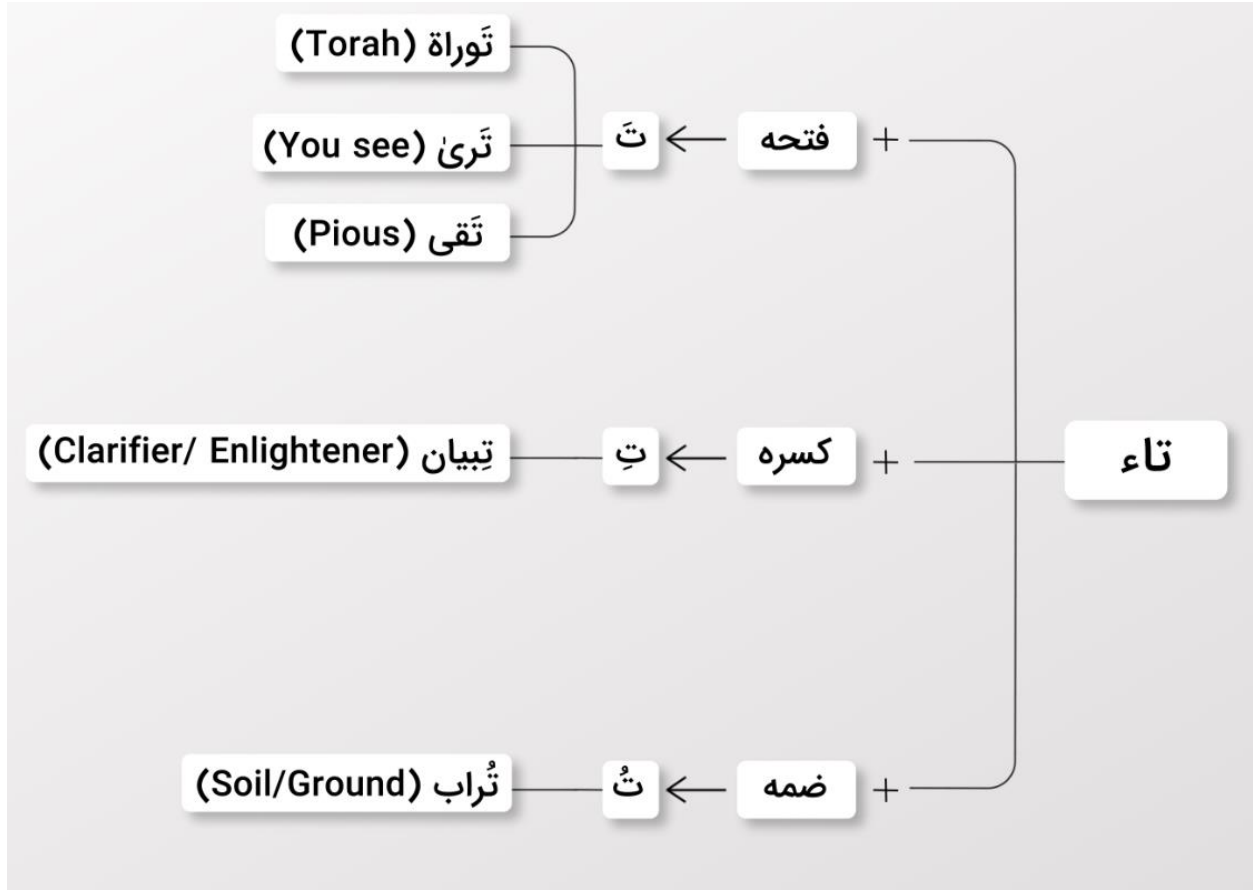

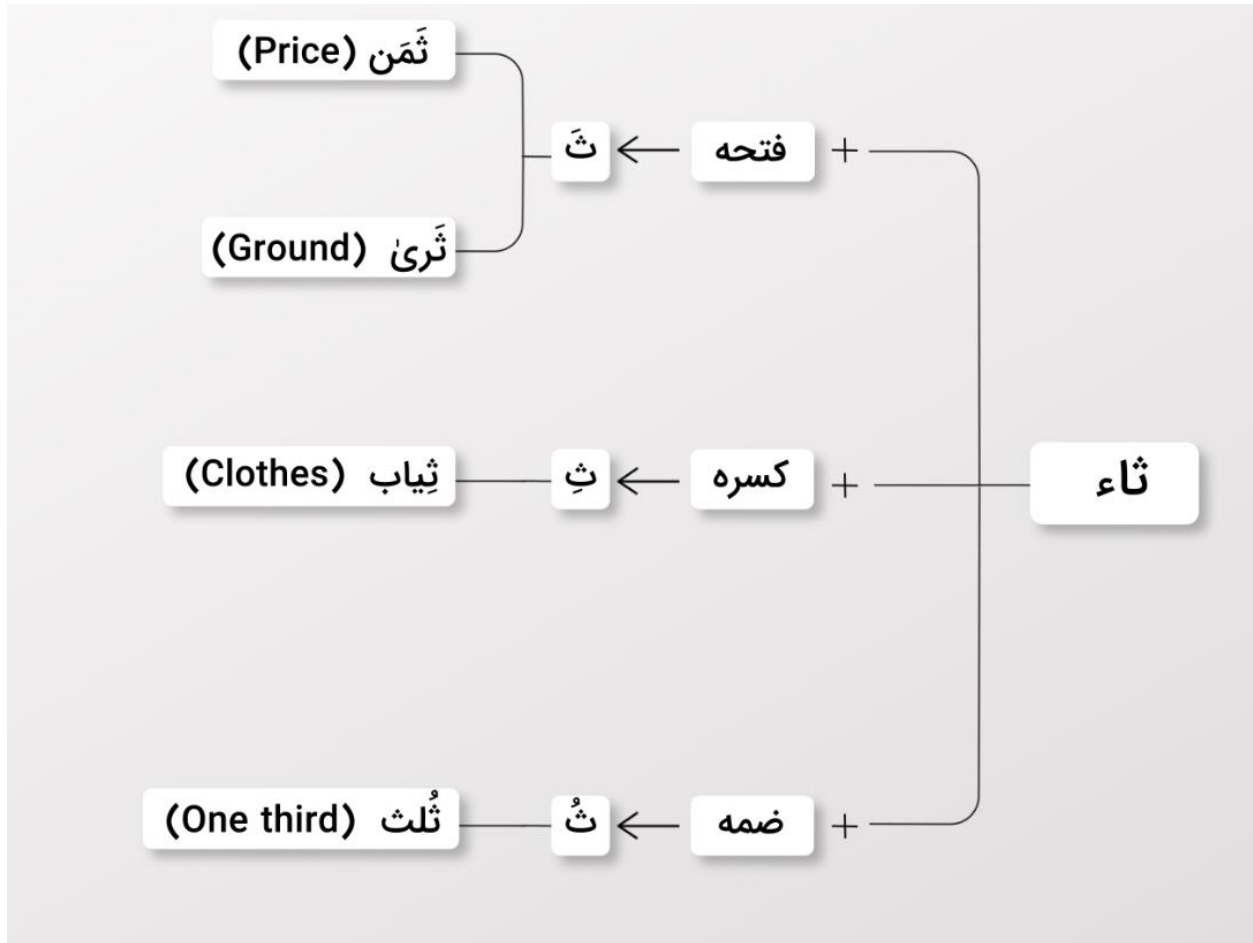
| Letter | Name | Transliteration | Pronunciation |
