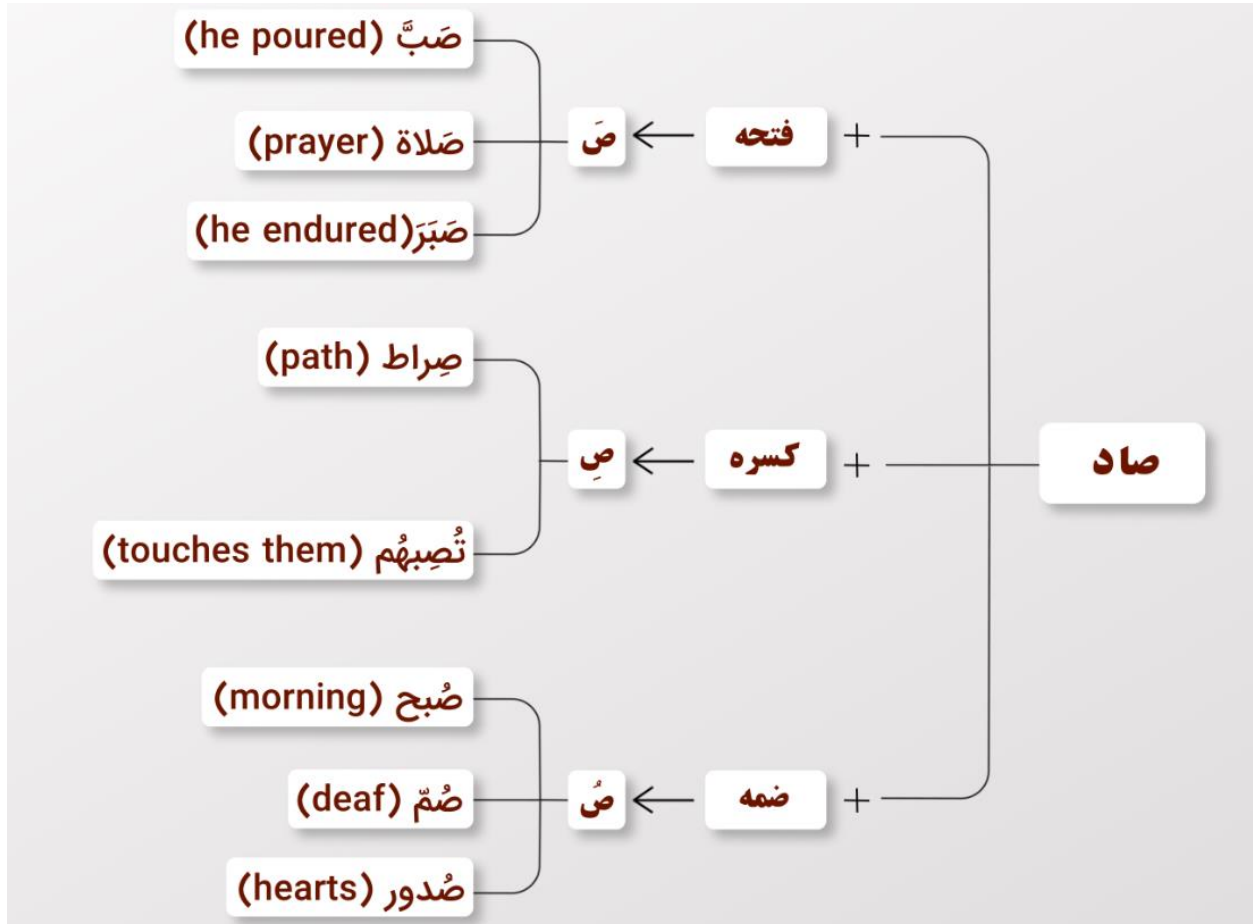
“Be mindful of Allah regarding to Qur’an, others shall not surpass you in acting upon it.”

ص	صاد	Ṣaad	It does not have an equivalent sound in English. The nearest sound is “S”, the sound is articulated the same way as “S” but part of the tongue, just after the tip moves towards the inner plates of the upper incisors and the letter “ص” is pronounced when the air is passed through the space between the tongue and the inner plates. The tongue is curved and “ص” is pronounced heavily.

ض	ضاد	<u>D</u> haad	It does not have an equivalent sound in English. The nearest sound is the

			<p>combination of “D” and “H”. this letter is articulated in two ways. 1) the tip of the tongue touches the back of the gums of the top incisors and a little further of the tongue touches the alveolar ridge. 2. One side of the tongue, left or right, touches the upper molar of the same side. This way is more accurate than the first one. In both ways the sound is pronounced heavily.</p>
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
