# Lesson: 24 Topic: The Birth of Imam al-Mahdi

#### The birth of Imam al-Mahdi<sup>\*\*\*\*</sup> was in secret circumstances because due to hundreds of hadiths regarding his birth, Abbasid caliphs were afraid and waiting for al-Mahdi. They knew that he would be the 12<sup>th</sup> Imam and 9<sup>th</sup> of the children of Imam al-Hussain<sup>\*\*\*</sup>.

There is a lot of proof in the Quran that there will be a savior at the end of time. (وَلَقَدْ كَتَبْنَا فِي الزَّبُورِ مِنْ بَعْدِ الذِّكْرِ أَنَّ الْأَرْضَ يَرِثُهَا عِبَادِيَ الصَّالِحُونَ»

"Certainly, We wrote in the Psalms, after the Torah: 'Indeed My righteous servants shall inherit the earth."" (21:105)

- Birth: 15<sup>th</sup> Sha'ban, 255 A.H.
- Father: Imam al-Askari<sup>꾇</sup>
- Mother: Lady Narjis

Martyrdom of his father: 260 A.H.

## Opinions about Imam al-Mahdi

- 1. She was a slave from Africa (Sudan)
- 2. She was a princess from the Roman Empire by the name of Melika (Malika)

## The story of how Lady Narjis 🕮 got to Samarra

Sources on Lady Narjis's story:

- The oldest: Kamal al-Din wa Tamam al-Ni'mah by Sheikh al-Saduq.
- Muruj al-Dhahab (Meadows of gold) by al-Masudi
- The Story of *Lady Narjis* is according to a hadith by al-Saduq (*riwaya of al-Shaibani*). Bishr ibn Sulayman al-Nakhas was the one sent by Imam al-Hadi<sup>®</sup> to buy her, and her name was *Malika*.

Disagreements about this narration:

1. There wasn't such a battle between Muslims and Romans at that particular time;

2. If a Roman princess were missing, it would be big news then.

 Al-Mufid and al-Kulayni pushed for another account that she was a slave in Hakima<sup>(1)</sup> (Imam al-Hadi<sup>(2)</sup>'s sister)'s house.

Some scholars pushed for al-Saduq's account:

- 1. Because of many relations and similarities between the Imam<sup>總</sup> and Prophet Isa<sup>劉</sup>
  - 2. It is an old account narrated by Sheikh al-Saduq
    - Some names of Lady Narjis<sup>1</sup>, according to Sheikh al-Tusi: Rayhana, Narjis, Saqeel, Susan

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• Al-Kulayni's hadith about Lady Narjis 🕮: She was an Umm-wald from al-Nawba.

Lady Narjis's death:

- Al-Saduq: She passed away before Imam al-Askari<sup>劉</sup>
- Al-Najashi: She passed away after Imam al-Askari<sup>繩</sup>
- She was buried near Imam al-Askari<sup>®</sup>.

- Whoever she was, we, the Shia, believe that mothers of Imams were all pure and untouched by the highest levels of faith because Allah would not allow someone impure to carry someone so pure.
- Imam al-Mahdi was born on the eve of Sha'ban 15, 255 A.H.
- A hadith narrated by Lady Hakima
  - Imam al-Askari<sup>總</sup> called for her
  - Invited her for Iftar on the eve of half of Sha'ban
  - "Allah will reveal His ultimate Hujja this night."
  - No sign of pregnancy was visible in Lady Narjis
  - Hakima informed Lady Narjis about what would happen that night.



- ImamSadiq.tv Near the time of Fajr, she began to doubt in her heart.
- Imam<sup>®</sup> told her not to rush and that the birth was near
- Near Fajr, lady Narjis 🕮 felt something.
- They both fainted for a while until Imam<sup>®</sup> awakened them.
- She saw the young lady in sujud.
- She hugged him and found him clean with no sign of filth.
- Then Imam al-Askari<sup>迴</sup> took him.
- The new-born Imam<sup>®</sup> spoke
- Imam<sup>迎</sup> told Sayyida Hakima<sup></sup> to return in 7 days.
- He wasn't there when Hakima wanted to see the baby before leaving. Imam al-Askari<sup>®</sup> told his aunt that he had put him under the protection of the one to whom the mother of Prophet Musa<sup>總</sup> left his baby.
  - Imam<sup>®</sup> recited these verses on the 7<sup>th</sup> day:

﴿وَنُرِيدُ أَن نَمُنَّ علَى الَّذِينَ اسْتُضْعِفُوا فِي الأرض وَنجعلَهم أئِمَّةً ونجعلَهمُ الْوارثِين. وَنُمَكّن لَهم في الأرض وَنُرِيَ فرعون وهامانَ وَجُنُودَهُما مِنهم ما كانوا يَحذَرُونَ ﴾ (28: 5-6)

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
