Conditions of Wudhu

Recommendations for Wudhu:

1. To perform Wudhu before the time of Adhan.
2. To enter a Masjid with Wudhu.
3. To enter the holy shrines with Wudhu.
4. To perform Sa'y between Safa and Marwa with Wudhu.
5. To perform Salat al-Mayyit with Wudhu.
6. To visit the graves with Wudhu.
7. For reciting the Quran.
8. For Dua (supplications)
9. To help a believer in the state of Wudhu.
10. To perform the prostration of gratification (Sajdat al-Shukr).
11. For Adhan.
12. A newly-wed couple should meet each other on the wedding night in the state of Wudhu.
13. To enter your house in the state of Wudhu upon returning from a journey.
14. To perform Wudhu before sleeping.
15. To pass judgment with Wudhu
16. It is highly recommended for a woman to perform Wudhu at the time of Salah during her menstrual cycle, and to sit on her prayer rug to remember Allah (swt).
17. For a person in the state of *Janabah*, it is *Makruh* to eat or drink anything, but he can remove the undesirability by performing Wudhu.

Conditions of Wudhu

1. The water must be pure.



- ✚ If the water available with us is impure and we do not have access to pure water, then we must perform Tayammum.

Conditions of Wudhu

2. The water must be plain, not mixed.
3. The water must be *Mubah* (permissible to use).

- ✚ If someone performs Wudhu with water that belongs to anyone else (stolen water), but he did not know that the water was stolen, in that case, his Wudhu is valid.

- ✚ If someone knew that the water was stolen but he forgot and performed Wudhu with it, in this case, his Wudhu is valid.

- ✚ If someone performed Wudhu with mixed water (like rose water) or impure water unknowingly or forgetfully, his Wudhu will be considered invalid.

Conditions of Wudhu

4. The body parts that are to be washed during the Wudhu must be pure.
5. The container used for Wudhu should not be made of gold or silver.
6. The use of water must not be prohibited for the person.

- ✚ If using water for Wudhu is harmful for someone but he insists on using it, his act will be considered sinful and the Wudhu will be deemed invalid.

Conditions of Wudhu

7. One must have sufficient time for performing Wudhu.
8. The person who is performing Wudhu must perform all the acts by himself.
