Acts of Wudhu

Conditions of Wudhu

9. To observe the sequence of Wudhu by beginning with washing the face, then the right hand, then the left hand, then wiping the head and the two feet.

10. While performing the Wudhu, one must observe *Muwalat*, i.e. to perform it in such a timely sequence that the previous body part does not become dry before washing the next part.

Obligatory Acts of Wudhu

1. Niyah (Intention)
2. Washing the face one time.

- ✚ Washing the face is obligatory from the origin of the hairline till the chin (vertically) and within the span of the thumb and the middle finger (horizontally).
- ✚ To wash the face, one must always move his hand from top to bottom, not the opposite way.
- ✚ Washing the face more than two times fully, invalidates the Wudhu.
- ✚ One of the conditions of Wudhu is that there should not be any barrier or obstacle for the water to reach the body parts.

Obligatory Acts of Wudhu

3. Washing the two hands, from the elbow to the tip of the fingers.
