### Topic; Al-Mu'arrif and Al-Hujjah

#### Section 4

## Apprehension (Tasawwur) is of two kinds:

- Apparent (Badeehi); such as the concept of fire
- Cognitive (nazari); which needs contemplation for comprehension.

# Likewise, Affirmation is of two kinds:

- Apparent; such as the concept of "fire is hot"
- Cognitive; which needs contemplation, like that God is the creator

#### **How to Attain Cognitive Apprehension and Affirmation:**

The method is to arrange the apparent apprehensions in a manner which leads to cognitive (nazari) apprehension and arrange apparent affirmations to lead to cognitive (nazari) affirmation.

#### Section 5

- ✓ Al-Mu'arrif (definien): Those apparent apprehensions by which one attains the cognitive apprehension
- ✓ Al-Hujjah (evidence): Those apparent affirmations by which one attains the cognitive affirmation

#### The Aim in Logic

The aim in logic is to recognize *mu'arrif* and *hujjah* in order to attain the unknown (cognitive) apprehension and affirmation.
