✓ Divisions of hamliyyah based on the nature of the maudoo'

Maudoo' (subject) in *hamliyyah* (qadiyyah) is of 4 types:

- concrete divisive concept → shakhsiyyah (individual) qadiyyah
- ✤ Kulli (universal):
- The hukm (mahmul) is for the kulli itself → tabee'iyyah (natural) qadiyyah
- The *hukm* is for the members:
- It is not clear if *hukm* is for all of the members or some of them → *muhmalah* (*indeterminate*) *qadiyyah*

• It is clear if *hukm* is for all the members or some of them → *mahsurah* (*restricted*) *qadiyyah*

Example:


Ali is standing.

طبيعيه: rationality is a fasl.

مهمله: the human is writer.

محصورہ: all humans are writers.

Muhmalah refers to mahsurah and the other two are not useful, so mahsurah is the only considerable qadiyyah.
