- ❖ In continuation, there are some other narrations about knowledge from Ahl al-Bayt, mentioning:
 - ✓ Whoever teaches others is awarded the same as the student is and moreover he has superiority.
 - ✓ Sitting in a gathering in which I accompany whom I am sure of his knowledge is more trustworthy than a year of worshipping acts.
 - ✓ If someone teaches another person or is the cause of guidance for the whole world, he receives a reward equivalent to which they do even after his death.
 - ✓ All of you should possess an insight into religion, otherwise, you are an illiterate desert nomad and God, the exalted, says: why don't they gain insight into religion and warn their people when coming back to them.
 - ✓ A person without profound knowledge in religion will be deprived of God's look of mercy on the Judgment Day and God will not accept any of his/her deeds.
 - ✓ Scholars are heirs to the Prophets; because they didn't leave wealth behind but their words and teachings.
 - ✓ Be aware as from whom you receive knowledge, in every generation there is a descendant of the holy prophet (Ahlul-Bait) who protects religion from deviation by the exaggerator, corrupted and ignorant.
 - ✓ When Allah wants well for one of his servants, he opens his eyes to have insight in His religion.
