 - ✓ A person who continuously endeavors to [spread our words](#) and in this way [gives strength to the hearts of Shi'as](#) is better than a thousand of worshippers.
 - ✓ No death is more [desirable for the devil](#) than the death of a knowledgeable scholar.
 - ✓ When an Islamic society loses a faithful, insightful scholar, they suffer a great loss, which nothing can compensate (other than a similar one).
 - ✓ When a faithful scholar dies, [angels, the land where he/she worshipped Allah](#) on it and the gates through which his deeds ascended to the heaven [will cry for him/her](#), because a scholar protects Islam [like the walls of a city](#) protect it.
 - ✓ The information in which there is no benefit for anyone or there is no harm in living without it, is [no knowledge, knowledge is of three types](#): the firm (essential) signs (beliefs), rithous duties (ethics and morality) and stable/permanent laws (of religion).
