- ✓ 11th Imam, Imam Hasan Askari (a):
 - Students will take up residence in houses and palaces in Heaven which are prepared for them in the vicinity of their teachers. They will be in the presence of the Imam who they became familiar with due to the struggles of these scholars.
 - On the other hand, the enemies will not be able to tolerate the rays which are given off by these crowns. It will make them blind, deaf and take away their power of speech.
 - These rays become such a penetrating power that they are more severe than the flames of hell.
- ✓ 12th Imam, Imam Mahdi (a):
 - The Imam introduces the scholars, who are aware of the traditions, as authorities and the real places of refuge in solving the intricacies and incidents which come up in life.
 - They should be referred to in order to know ones human and spiritual duty when dealing with the various complications in life.
 - In dealing with any complications in life refer to those who narrate our traditions,
 because they are my proclamation for you and I am God's proclamation (hujjat)
- ✓ In the View of the Sages and Ancient Holy Books
 - Luqman: "My dear child,
 - Open your eyes in your choices of gatherings. If you see that the gathering is composed of people who remember God with their hearts, souls and tongues, then participate in them.
 - And when you come upon a group who are unaware of God, then do not associate with them."
 - The Torah: God tells P. Moses (a);
 - Know that knowledge, wisdom and firmness in thought, words, and behavior are wondrous things. Honor them!
 - The Book of Psalms: Gods tells P. David(a);

David, make aware the priests, scholars, and monks of the children of Israel to have discussion with the pious people, If not, then scholars, if not, then sit with the wise men, because piety, knowledge and wisdom are three stages. God wants people to go through these 3 stages so that they don't suffer a lapse in morality.
