The indicator of the pronouns of the subjects in all the dual forms is ''', ' $\dot{\upsilon}$ ' in the 6th and 12th seeghah and ' $\dot{\upsilon}$ ' in the 10th. In seeghah 1,4,7, 13 & 14, the indicators are concealed.

Normally, the present tense verb is Mu'rab and its l'rab is 'رَفَع'. Its sign in Seeghah 1,4,7,13&14 is the Dhammah on the third original letter. In the duals, 3^{rd} , 9^{th} and 10^{th} , the sign of Raf' is Noon (النّونُ الإعرابي).
