## The Passive Voice Verb (الفِعلُ المَجهول)

#### **Past Tense Passive Voice Verb**

This verb is derived from the past tense active voice verb.

#### Formation:

The vowel on the first original letter gets changed from Fathah to Dhammah (فُعَلَ  $\rightarrow$  فُعَلُ). The second step is to change the vowel on the second original letter to kasrah (فُعِلَ  $\rightarrow$  فُعِلُ). According to this, the past tense passive voice verb has only this one pattern.

As previously said, the passive voice is conjugated according to the proxy subject (نائب الفاعل).
