The Passive Voice Command Verb (الأمر المجهول)

This verb is derived from the present tense passive voice verb.

Formation:

The method is to prefix the particle of the command (\bot) and remove the signs of Raf' from the end of the verb.

The Passive Voice of the Intransitive Verb

A transitive verb requires an object in order to complete its meaning, so the passive voice verb is derived from a transitive verb. In order to convert an intransitive verb to a passive voice, it must first be made transitive by a preposition. E.g., خَفَبَ زَيدٌ بِكِتَابٍ \rightarrow Zaid went. \rightarrow Zaid took a book

Now to form the passive verb, the preposition and the object will replace the subject \rightarrow ذُهِبَ بِكِتَابٍ (A book was taken)

The passive voice verb that is derived from the intransitive verb is conjugated according to the object i.e., the verb itself will only be in the form of the first *seeghah*.
