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The active participle (إِسْمُ الْفَاعِلِ), also known as the agent noun which denotes the performer of the verb, is derived from the active voice verb.

(killer) قَاتِلٌ ← (He killed) قَتَلَ
(Knower) عَالِمٌ ← (he knew) عَلِمَ

These and other nouns will be examined in detail in the second part of the book.

Chapter Two

The Non-Sound Verb (الفعل غير السالم)

As previously mentioned, the word that does not have neither doubled consonants (*Mudhaa'af*) nor *Hamzah* as one of its original letters (*Mahmooz*) is known as *Saalim*.
