## Lesson 20

## Cases where the letters Waw (3) and Yaa (3) are not pronounced

- a. When the wo letters are not accompanied by any vowel and are situated after the short Alif  $\binom{\perp}{-}$  e.g.  $\frac{1}{2}$
- b. When the two letters (  $\omega$  and  $\vartheta$ ) function as a 'seat' for Hamzah.

If the long Vowels (Madd) are followed by Hamzat al-Wasl → the Madd pronunciation becomes Silent.

Joining two Sakin Letters

Two Sakin Letters together cannot be pronounced.

In cases where there is a Taween at the end of the 1st word and the 2nd word begins with hamzat al-Wasl like الله عَرَضَنْ)عَرَضَاً عَرَضَانْ)عَرَضَاً .

In such cases we should give a Kasrah to Noon of the Tanween (نِ) . If you do not stop at عَرَضاً you will read it as: عَرَضَ نِ الَّذِينَ
