Knowledge is defined as: "The presence of something's image in the intellect".

There are four stages of perception and knowledge:

- 1. The Sensual knowledge (العلم الحسى)
- 2. The Imaginary knowledge (العلم الخيالي)
- 3. The Estimative knowledge (العلم الوهمى)
- 4. The Perfect knowledge (العلم الاكمل)

At the fourth stage humans separate from the animals.

The Difference between Immediate and Acquired Knowledge

When the known itself is present in the owner of knowledge, it is called *al-ilm al-hoduri* (knowledge by presence or immediate knowledge) and if not, it's called *al-ilm al-hosuli* (acquired knowledge).
