The Ignorance and its Divisions (1)

(العلم و الجهل) Knowledge and Ignorance

Knowledge and ignorance are based on the presence or absence of a given faculty (ملکه و عدم ملکه). We would not call a rock "blind". The contradictory relationship between "blindness" and "sight" is a kind of opposition of privation and possession.

Conceptional & Assent Ignorance (الجهل التصديق) التصديقي) الجهل التصديقي) Conceptional & Assent Ignorance

Ignorance has two divisions; insofar as ignorance is always contrasted to knowledge. Sometimes it is reciprocal to a conception and sometimes to an assent. It is correct to use the terms conceptional-ignorance and assent-ignorance.

Simple & Compound Ignorance (الجهل البسيط و الجهل المركّب)

Simple Ignorance (الجهل البسـيط): This is a situation where someone is ignorant about a thing, but he is aware of his ignorance and knows that he does not know.

Compound Ignorance (الجهل المركّب): This is ignorance about a thing, but combined with ignorance about one's ignorance. Such a person believes that he has knowledge where he does not.
