The Divisions of Signification(2)

The movement of the mind from one thing to the other only occurs through a cause. The

cause is nothing other than the firm bond existing between the two things.

The relationship and concomitance in signification also have a cause, which is knowledge of the necessary relationship between these two things outside of the mind.

Based on the nature of the relationship and concomitance in signification, it's divided

1) Rational Signification (الدلالة العقلية); e.g., the morning light in the sky is the effect of the sunrise.

2) Natural Signification (الدلالة الطبيعية); e.g., "ouch" signifies pain.

3) Contractual Signification (الدلالة الوضعية); e.g., road signs.
