The Divisions of Words

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(الترادُف و التَبايُن) Synonymity and Dissonance

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There are two divisions of words when in comparison to other words: Taraduf and Tabayun.

الترادف: «اشتراك الألفاظ المتعددة في معني واحد»

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Synonymity (الترادف): Commonality of multiple words (by coinage) in one meaning; such as beautiful and pretty or fair, just and unbiased.

التباين: «أن تكون معانى الألفاظ متكثرة بتكثر الألفاظ»

Dissonance (التباین): Difference in meanings by difference in words (by coinage); such as sword, iron, weapon, glass etc.

The "تباین" here is different from the "تباین" in logical relations (which will be discussed later). Here, "تباین" means the difference in words as they have different

meanings, even if their external existences may be always the same. For example, two human and rational animal are different in meaning but common in existence.

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
