

Divisions of Opposition

There are four kinds of opposition:

- 1) Contradictories (تقابل النقيضَين)
- (تقابل ملکه و عدم ملکه) The opposition of privation and possession
- 3) Contrariety (غيد الله): The example would be hot and cold, black and white etc. Contraries are two reciprocal adjectives, related to a single object which cannot be simultaneously predicated on the same object, and for which the intellection of one does not depend on the other.

Contrariety (ضِدّان)

When both things are existing:

- They are two reciprocal adjectives.
- They cannot be simultaneously predicated on the same object.
- The intellection of one does not depend on the other.



4) **Correlatives (مُ**تَّضَايِفَانُ): Such as above and below, cause and effect etc. The intellection of one of these concepts requires the intellection of the other concept. Secondly, they cannot be predicated on the same thing, so long as that thing is observed from a single perspective.
