Im a m S • d Difference between Essential and Accidental:

- 1. Essential "ذاتى" is the predicate that constitutes the essence of its subject, but accidental "عرضى" is the predicate out of the essence of its subject.
- 2. Essential is on the same level as essence, but accidental comes after the essential.
- Accidental:

General accident (عرض عام): The predicate which is not a part of its subject's essence and it is (inclusively) common with other species, such as walking ''ماشی'' to human ''انسان'' mam Sadig.ty @ Imam Sadig.ty

> Property (خاصة): The predicate which is not part of its subject's essence but is (exclusively) peculiar to it, such as laughing ''ضاحک'' to a human ''انسان''.
